Preschool News!

There is a new *Child Development and Early Learning Framework*. Yes, this is a revised version of the new Framework. It still has eleven domains, but has an inner circle. The Framework's inner circle consists of five essential domains which align with the National Education Goals Panel and lays out essential areas of learning and development. Each program should have at least one school readiness goal representing each of the five essential domains. The domains and domain elements apply to all 3 to 5 year olds in Head Start.
